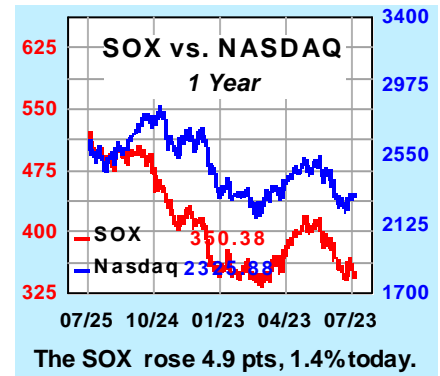
U.S. stocks rose today as financial shares climbed on hopes lawmakers will approve a rescue plan for mortgage finance companies Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac and as the price of oil fell. Financial shares rose after President George W. Bush dropped a threat to veto a housing rescue bill,

The Dow Jones industrial average rose 29.88 points, or 0.26 percent, to 11,632.38

The Standard & Poor's 500 Index gained 5.11 points, or 0.40 percent, to 1,282.11, a three-week closing high.

The Nasdaq Composite Index was up 21.92 points, or 0.95 percent, at 2,325.88.

The SOX index rose 4.9 points after tumbling 14 points yesterday.

Aehr Test said its sales were \$10.9 million in the fourth quarter of fiscal 2008, an increase of 32% from \$8.3 million in the fourth quarter of fiscal 2007. Its net income of \$6.5 million, or \$0.74 per diluted share, in the fourth quarter of fiscal 2008, compared with net income of \$919,000, or \$0.11 per diluted share, in the fourth quarter of fiscal 2007. However weak guidance for the present quarter resulted in a 29% drop in its stock price today
